STUDENTS SKILLS LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT

- Storytelling and Communication: Throughout the month, we'll use pictures as prompts for creative storytelling. This encourages critical thinking and expressive language skills.
- Building Vocabulary: Each week, we'll memorize at least one poem or song in English and Vietnamese, enriching their vocabulary and appreciation for different languages.
- Portfolio Creation: Your child will select their best work each month for their portfolio, allowing you to track their progress and celebrate their achievements.
- Event: Show & Tell: Presenting to their peers builds selfassurance and communication skills.

SELF-HELP SKILLS

- Practice Self-Service Skills: Packing snacks, putting on sunscreen, and changing into appropriate clothing are all opportunities for independence.

CREATIVE THINKING SKILLS

- Open-Ended Questions: Our teachers will incorporate openended questions in all activities, prompting children to think critically and devise creative solutions. This will encourage independent thought and curiosity.
